

b Complete any bar where * is marked by adding the necessary rest or rests.




2 a Add the missing barlines to each of the following tunes.

3 Rewrite the melody at the same pitch in the treble clef.




4 Write the following scales. Include a key signature if needed and include any necessary accidentals.




5 a Add a note above each of these notes to make the named interval. Some notes may need accidentals.

7 Carefully think through the sound of these two bars and write another two bars to finish the tune. End on doh.


